## WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS

# October 1, 2025 Exodus 32:1-6

#### **Introduction:**

- 1. Why did the children of Israel apostasize so quickly?
  - a) Misplaced trust: **Exodus 32.1:** "Now when the people saw that Moses delayed"
  - b) Misconception of God: **Exodus 32.1:** "make us gods that shall go before us"
  - c) Misguided memories: **Psalm 106.19-21:** "They forgot God their Savior"
- 2. In verses 2-6, we read about Aaron role in their departure.

## I. AARON BECAME A FOLLOWER

- A. What was Aaron's role in the nation of Israel?
  - 1. **Exodus 32.1:** "the people gathered together to Aaron" Why?
  - 2. Aaron was the spokesman for Moses. (Ex. 4.15,16; 16.9,10)
  - 3. Aaron was a judge over Israel. (Ex. 24.14; cf. Ex. 18.22)
- B. Aaron went from leader to follower.
  - 1. Exodus 32.2: "Break off the golden earrings" (cf. Ps. 7.2),
  - 2. **Exodus 32.2:** the golden earrings which are in the ears" (cf Ex. 12.35),
  - 3, Exodus 32.2: "in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters"

### II. AARON BECAME A FASHIONER

- A. Aaron fashioned the golden calf.
  - 1. **Exodus 32.3:** "So all the people broke off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them to Aaron" Not the artisans, but to Aaron.
  - 2. **Exodus 32.3:** "he received the gold from their hand, and he fashioned it"
    - a) This was in direct violation of God's command. (Ex. 20.4)
    - b) Why a golden calf? The Egyptian god Osirus was represented by a bull.
- B. The people made a declaration.
  - 1. **Exodus 32.4:** "Then they said, 'These are your gods, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt." (cf. Deut. 9.15,16)
  - 2. How did Aaron respond to this declaration?

## III. AARON BECAME A FACILITATOR

- A. Aaron blended their idolatry with true worship.
  - 1. **Exodus 32.5:** "So when Aaron saw it..." Literally, Came to realize.
  - 2. **Exodus 32.5**; "Aaron made a proclamation and said, 'Tomorrow is a feast to the LORD." Aaron tried to prevent them from complete apostasy.
- B. The feast of celebration.
  - 1. **Exodus 32.6:** "Then they rose up early the next day, offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings" Offer to whom? (Ex. 32.8)
  - 2, **Exodus 32.6:** "The people sat down to eat and drink and rose up to play"
