WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS March 27, 2024 Exodus 3:13-22

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Calling Moses to be the agent of emancipation for Israel was met with apprehension.
 - a) EXODUS 3.11: "Who am I that I should to go Pharaoh?"
 - b) Sometimes we are expected to do difficult things. (Jonah 1.1-3; Luke 22.41,42)
 - c) What was God's answer to Moses? (Ex. 3.12)
- 2. Having invalidated his first objection, Moses poses a second objection.

I. THE APPREHENSION OF MOSES

- A. Moses was concerned about questions that he could not answer.
 - 1. **EXODUS 3.13:** "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel...and they say to me, "What is His name?" what shall I say to them?"
 - 2. Why would Moses be concerned about this question?
 - a) The name of God was never known by the children of Israel. (Ex. 6.3)
 - b) Was Moses looking for validation? (Ex. 2.14; Acts 7.25)
- B. Does the lack of answers make you apprehensive to talk to others?
 - 1. Are you concerned about sounding judgmental? (Gen. 19.9)
 - 2. Are you concerned about sounding superior? (Num. 16.3,13)
 - 3. Are you looking for validation? "You're no scholar!" (Matt. 21.23)
 - 4. Are you worried about being insulted? (1 Pet. 4.4)
 - 5. Are you concerned that you don't know how to answer? (1 Pet. 3.15)

II. THE ANSWER OF GOD

- A. God gave Moses the answers he needed to convey to Israel.
 - 1. God gave Moses two descriptions.
 - a) **EXODUS 3.14:** *"Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you."* Tetragrammaton. The self-existing One. (cf. John 5.26)
 - b) **EXODUS 3.15:** *"The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you."*
 - c) **EXODUS 3.15:** "This is My name forever" (Ps. 72.17; Hos. 12.5)
 - 2. God gives Moses two messages to convey.
 - a) **Exodus 3.16,17:** "Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them..."
 - b) **EXODUS 3.18:** *"and you shall come, you and the elders of Israel, to the king of Egypt; and you shall say to him..."*
 - 3. God predicts two reactions.
 - a) **EXODUS 3.18:** The elders "will heed your voice."
 - b) **Exodus 3.19:** "But I am sure that the king of Egypt will not let you go"
 - 4. God will show His glory in two ways.
 - a) **EXODUS 3.20:** "I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt"
 - b) **EXODUS 3.21,22:** "You shall plunder the Egyptians"
- B. How can we stir up the courage to talk to others about the gospel?
 - 1. God had already told us what to say. (Matt. 10.19,20; 2 Tim. 3.16)
 - 2. God has predicted two reactions. (Acts 14.4; 17.4,5; 28.24; Ezek. 3.4-9)
 - 3. God gave us two ways to convey His message. (1 Pet. 3.1,2; Prov. 18.19; Matt. 28.19)
