Leviticus 7:1-10

Introduction:

1. Leviticus 6.8 transitions into the instructions given to the priests. (cf. Lev. 1.2; 6.8,9)
2. Review of the laws given to Israel concerning trespass offering
 - a) Three different categories of sins. (Lev. 5.15,17; 6.2)
 - b) A sacrificial ram was required. (Lev. 5.18)
 - c) Restitution is required emphasizing a debt that is owed. (Lev. 5.18)
3. In our text, the priests were instructed how to administer this sacrifice.

I. THE PROCEDURE

- A. There is a declaration.
 1. **Leviticus 7.1:** *“Likewise this is the law of the trespass offering...”*
 - a) Law (torah): Not a codified law, but a set of instructions.
 - b) God gave specific instructions for each sacrifice. (Lev. 6.9,14,25; 7.1,11)
 2. **Leviticus 7.1:** *“(it is most holy):”*
 - a) Sets the premise of the instructions that follow.
 - b) Three sacrifices carried the same level of importance. (Lev. 6.25,29,17)
 3. The trespass offering was a shadow of Christ. (Isa. 53.10)
- B. There is a designation.
 1. **Leviticus 7.2:** The slaughter of the animal. (cf. Lev. 6.15; 1.5)
 2. **Leviticus 7.2:** The flinging of the blood. (cf. Lev. 4.7)
- C. There is a dedication.
 1. **Leviticus 7.3:** *“and he shall offer from it all its fat”*
 2. **Leviticus 7.3-5:** Three different areas specified.

II. THE PROVISIONS

- A. Eating from the trespass offering.
 1. Who could eat of the trespass offering?
 - a) **Leviticus 7.6:** *“Every male among the priests may eat it”*
 - b) Why were only the males allowed to eat of it? (cf. Lev. 10.14)
 2. Where were they to eat it?
 - a) **Leviticus 7.6:** *“It shall be eaten in a holy place.”*
 - b) Where is a holy place? (Lev. 6.16)
 3. How were they to eat it? (Lev. 7.6)
- B. The Law of Provisions
 1. **Leviticus 7.7:** The same law in reference to provisions.
 2. **Leviticus 7.8-10:** Other provisions given to the priests.
 3. This was God’s law to support the work of the priesthood. (cf. Num. 18.8-32)
