

## WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS

Exodus 39:22-31

### Introduction:

1. How you dress matters. Someone will choose what they wear by considering the kind of image they want to present.
2. The priests were given a dress code. God commanded them to wear specific garments when they served Him in the tabernacle.
  - a) The high priest: Breastplate, ephod, robe, tunic, turban, and sash. (Ex. 28.4)
  - b) The priesthood: Tunics, sashes, hats, and trousers. (Ex. 28.40-42)
3. Exodus 39 records these garments being made. (cf. Ex. 39.32)

### I. THE REMAINING PIECES

- A. **Exodus 39.22-26:** The priestly robe. (cf. Ex. 28.31-35)
  - a) How was the robe made?
  - b) Who wore the robe? (Ex. 28.30,31)
- B. **Exodus 39.27:** The skillfully woven tunics. (cf. Ex. 28.39)
  - a) How were the tunics made?
  - b) Who wore the tunics? (Ex. 39.27)
- C. **Exodus 39.28:** A turban and hats. (cf. Ex. 28.39,40)
  - a) How was the turban made?
  - b) How were the hats made?
  - c) Who wore the turban and hats? (Ex. 28.4,40)
- D. **Exodus 39.28:** Trousers. (cf. Ex. 28.42,43)
  - a) How were the trousers made?
  - b) Who wore the trousers?
- E. **Exodus 39.29:** Sashes. (cf. Ex. 28.39,40)
  - a) How were the sashes made?
  - b) Who wore the sashes? (Ex. 39.29)

### II. THE MODERN DAY PRIESTLY DRESS CODE

- A. Who are the priests in the church today?
  1. Priests are not those separated from the rest of the "laity." (cf. Matt. 23.5-12)
  2. Every member of the Lord's church is a priest. (1 Pet. 2.5,9; Heb. 13.15)
- B. As the Lord's priesthood, how are we to dress in our service to God?
  1. **1 Peter 5.5:** "*be clothed with humility*" Literally, to think lowly. (cf. Phil. 2.3)
  2. **1 Timothy 2.9,10:** "*which is proper for professing godliness*"
    - a) "Modest apparel" - outside. "Propriety" - emotions. "Moderation" - mind.
    - b) "*Professing godliness*" What you wear sends a message.
  3. **Ephesians 6.10-17:** "*Put on the whole armor of God*"
  4. **Colossians 3.12-14:** "*Put on tender mercies, kindness, humility...*"
