Leviticus 6:8-30

Introduction:

1. The five sacrifices governed Israel's relationship with God.
 - a) These sacrifices emphasized the holiness of God. (Deut. 9.7,24; Rom. 3.9-12)
 - b) These sacrifices were not to be viewed casually. (Lev. 2.3,10; 6.17; 7.1)
 - c) These sacrifices were the shadows of the offering of Christ. (Heb. 10.1,10)
2. What is the difference in the instructions given in this section? (Lev. 1.2; 6.8,9)
3. These instructions were given as commandments. (Lev. 6.9; cf. Num. 28.2; Col. 3.17)

I. THE BURNT OFFERING

- A. Instructions given to the priests.
 1. **Leviticus 6.9:** The duration of the sacrifice.
 2. **Leviticus 6.10-12:** The dress of the sacrifice. (cf. Ezek. 44.17,18)
- B. The emphasis of the perpetual fire.
 1. **Leviticus 6.9:** *"the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it."*
 2. **Leviticus 6.12:** *"...it shall not be put out."*
 3. **Leviticus 6.13:** *"...always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out."*

II. THE BURNT OFFERING

- A. The green offering from the Israelites.
 1. **Leviticus 6.14,15:** They were to offer a handful. (Lev. 2.1-3)
 2. **Leviticus 6.16:** They were to eat a portion of it.
 3. **Leviticus 6.17,18:** They were to treat it as holy.
- B. The grain offering from the priests.
 1. **Leviticus 6.19,20:** *"This is the offering of Aaron and his sons"*
 2. **Leviticus 6.21:** It was to be baked. (v. 17)
 3. **Leviticus 6.22:** It was to be completely burned.

III. THE SIN OFFERING

- A. Instructions concerning the sin offerings of rulers or commoners.
 1. **Leviticus 6.24,25:** The location of the offering. (cf. Lev. 1.2)
 2. **Leviticus 6.26:** The consumption of the offering. (cf. Lev. 10.16-18)
 3. **Leviticus 6.27-29:** The consecration of the offering.
- B. Instructions concerning the sin offering of the congregation or the priests.
 1. **Leviticus 6.30:** Sin offerings where the blood was brought into the tabernacle could be eaten.
 2. **Leviticus 6.30:** *"It shall be burned in the fire."*
