## WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS

# August 27 2025 Exodus 30:7-10

### **Introduction:**

- 1. Exodus 30 begins with the design and location of the altar of incense.
  - a) **The design:** a cubit square and two cubits high. (Ex. 30.1-5)
  - b) **The location:** "before the veil" in the Holy Place. (Ex. 30.6)
- 2. In verses 7-10, 34-38 we read about details of the incense and its preparation.

#### I. RECIPE

- A. It was something only Aaron and his descendants could burn.
  - 1. **Exodus 30.7:** "Aaron shall burn" (Num. 16.39,40)
  - 2. Uzziah was punished for burning incense. (2 Chr. 26.16-20)
  - 3. Why was Zacharias able to burn incense? (Luke 1.5-11)
- B. It was composed of specific ingredients.
  - 1. Exodus 30.7: "Aaron shall burn on it sweet incense"
  - 2. "Sweet" (sam): Literally, fragrant, aroma, smell. (cf. 2 Cor. 2.14-16)
  - 3. Exodus 30.34: Four main ingredients. (cf. Jer. 6.20)
- C. It was made according to a specific process.
  - 1. Exodus 30.35: "You shall make of these an incense"
  - 2. The incense was to be "a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, pure, and holy" (v. 35). Preserved and without impurities.
  - 3. Exodus 30.36: "And you shall beat some of it very fine"

## II. REGULATIONS

- A. When was Aaron to offer incense?
  - 1. **Exodus 30.7:** "every morning; when he tends the lamps"
  - 2. **Exodus 30.8:** "And when Aaron lights the lamps at twilight"
  - 3. **Exodus 30.8:** "a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations." (cf. Ex. 29.38,39,42)
- B. How was Aaron to offer it?
  - 1. **Exodus 30.9:** "You shall not offer strange incense on it"
    - a) "Strange" (zorah): foreign, alien, outside, profane. The idea is that it is foreign to God's specific commands.
    - b) Leviticus 10.1-3: "offered profane fire...which He had not commanded "
  - 2. Exodus 30.9: No other offerings were to be made. (Deut. 31.21; Ps. 139.1-4)
- C. It was made for a specific purpose.
  - 1. **Exodus 30.10:** Burned once a year for atonement.
  - 2. Exodus 30.37: "You shall not make any for yourselves" (cf. Ex. 30.32,33)
  - 3. Exodus 30.37,38: "It shall be to you holy for the Lord'
