November 26, 2025 Exodus 33:18

Introduction:

- 1. Exodus 33 find Moses making a series of requests.
 - a) Exodus 33.13: "show me now Your way, that I may know You"
 - b) **Exodus 33.13:** "And consider that this nation is Your people."
 - c) **Exodus 33.15:** "do not bring us up from here."
- 2. Moses makes what is perhaps one of the most significant requests to God: "Please, show me Your glory" (Exodus 33.18)

I. THE GLORY OF GOD

- A. Exodus 33.18: "Please, show me Your glory."
 - 1. Glory (kabod): Literally, "heaviness; riches, importance." The former implies the latter. (cf. Gen. 31.1; 1 Kings 3.13)
 - 2. **Exodus 33.19:** "Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you"
 - a) The glory of God is seen in His goodness.
 - b) Goodness (tob): "Prosperity, blessing, well-being." (cf. Neh. 9.25)
- B. How is the goodness of God manifested?
 - 1. **Exodus 33.19:** "and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you."
 - 2. Exodus 33.19: "I will be gracious...and I will have compassion"
 - 3. Only God decides who will receive His mercy. (Rom. 9.14,15; Jonah 4.1-3)

II. THE PROTECTION OF GOD

- A. Exodus 33.20-23: God protects Moses from His essence
 - 1. **Exodus 33.20:** "No one can see Me and live." (cf. Gen. 32.30).
 - a) No one can see the unmediated essence of God. (1 Tim. 6.16; John 1.18)
 - b) Those who saw God saw His representation. (Num. 12.8; Deut. 4.15,16; 5.24)
 - 2. **Exodus 33.21-23:** "Then I will take away My hand, and you shall see My back; but My face shall not be seen." The idea is the wake or aftermath.
 - 3. What did Moses see?
 - a) Exodus 34.5: "proclaimed the name of the LORD."
 - b) **Exodus 34.6,7:** The glory of God is seen in His mercy, grace, longsuffering, goodness, truth, forgiveness, and righteousness.
- B. Will we see the glory of God?
 - 1. The glory of God is manifested in His creation. (Ps. 19.1; Matt. 5.45; Acts 14.17)
 - 2. The glory of God is seen in the person of Jesus. (2 Cor. 4.6; John 3.16)
 - 3. The glory of God is shown to us in His blessings. (John 11.40)
 - 4. 1 John 3.1-3: "We shall see Him as He is"
